**Bring with you:** A copy of current Med Forms for all Scouts & Scouters along with two copies of your Troop's roster (list of attendees with rank/position). District rules now require that the med forms be delivered in a manila envelope with one copy of the roster taped to the outside. The envelopes will be filed for Medical personnel. The second roster is for Registration. If you do not meet the Oct 1st registration deadline, please also bring the completed registration form with you, along with registration & late fees. **Bring fire buckets, water and Class A Uniforms.**

**Carry in - Carry out!** Please bring some heavy trash bags so you can remove all trash for disposal at home. (Plan camping methods that minimize waste volume by avoiding disposable cups, plates, leaving excess packaging behind, etc.) Bring makings for gray-water sump bags (tripod, burlap sack with hay inside and big heavy trash bag to pack it out)

**Gateway Competition:** Plan ahead to come up with the best gateway display based on “Scouts having Fun.”

**Please carpool - We have limited parking - Thank you.** Sites are accessible to one troop vehicle at a time. The Staff will park you. **After parking** a unit Leader must proceed to the Headquarters tent with Med forms & roster, and receive their site assignment.

**Set up your sites** with tents along the outside of long sides, facing inward, to allow you easy access to & from your camp without cutting thru a neighbors site. All sites are required to have a gray-water sump bag, set up away from the tents and out of walking paths. (the sump is a burlap bag, lined with hay, suspended from a tripod, to filter your waste water from brushing, washing, cooking, etc.) Bring a large, heavy-duty plastic bag to secure it in for the ride home.

**Porta-potties** will be available in the camping and activity areas. Please have respect for other Scouts & Scouters by keeping the toilets CLEAN.

**Above-ground fires** will be allowed on each site, as long as we are not under dry conditions.

**All Scouts need their Class A uniforms as we will be doing a permanent Flag Retirement Ceremony Saturday night.**

Continue to follow ME-4.

Turn LEFT onto SOKOKIS TRL/ME-5. Continue to follow ME-5. 10.3 mi

Turn RIGHT onto WASHINGTON ST/ME-11. 0.9 mi

Turn LEFT onto EMERY CORNER RD. 0.7 mi

Turn LEFT onto QUARRY RD. 2.1 mi

Turn RIGHT onto NASON RD 0.5 mi

**From Route 5, (Saco, Biddeford, Hollis)**

Continue to follow ME-5.

Turn RIGHT onto WASHINGTON ST/ME-11. 0.9 mi

Turn LEFT onto EMERY CORNER RD. 0.7 mi

Turn LEFT onto QUARRY RD. 2.1 mi

Turn RIGHT onto NASON RD 0.5 mi

**From Route 11, (Shapleigh, Springvale)**

Continue to follow ME-11.

Turn RIGHT onto WASHINGTON ST/ME-11. 0.9 mi

Turn LEFT onto EMERY CORNER RD. 0.7 mi

Turn LEFT onto QUARRY RD. 2.1 mi

Turn RIGHT onto NASON RD 0.5 mi

**From Points South (coming via Maine Turnpike)**

Merge onto I-95 N/GOLD STAR MEMORIAL HWY/MAINE TURNPIKE toward PORTLAND (Portions toll).

Take the ME-111 exit, EXIT 32, toward BIDDEFORD. 0.4 mi

Turn RIGHT onto ALFRED ST/ME-111/CARL BROGGI HWY. Continue to follow ME-111/CARL BROGGI HWY. 3.5 mi

Turn RIGHT onto HILL RD. 2.1 mi

Turn SLIGHT LEFT onto CHURCH ST. 0.2 mi

Turn SLIGHT RIGHT onto GOODWINS MILLS RD/ME-35. 2.8 mi

Turn LEFT onto NEW COUNTY RD/ME-35/ME-5. Continue to follow NEW COUNTY RD/ME-5. 3.6 mi

Turn SLIGHT LEFT onto US-202/ME-4/ME-5/BARTLETTS BRIDGE. Continue to follow ME-5. 12.1 mi

Turn RIGHT onto WASHINGTON ST/ME-11. 0.9 mi

Turn LEFT onto EMERY CORNER RD. 0.7 mi

Turn LEFT onto QUARRY RD. 2.1 mi

Turn RIGHT onto NASON RD 0.5 mi
