Welcome to the York District Fall Camporee hosted by Troop 312 of North Berwick, ME. The "Harvest Dining" theme combines the cooking etiquette and skills competition with a number of fall Scouting skills that will tell us all what we need to prepare on the road towards the Klondike Derby in February or is related to our harvest dining theme.

Webelos

Webelos are encouraged to come to the Camporee on Saturday and stay overnight. They will be able to see activities that are going on for that day as well as the cooking. Webelos should arrive with a one to one parent or guardian ratio.

Scout Spirit/Campfire

Each Patrol needs to prepare a song, skit, or cheer and provide that to the staff for participation in the Saturday evening campfire. Bring flashlights for travel to and return to your campsite.

Gateways

Troops are asked to prepare a gateway for their unit's campsite at the Camporee. Please remember the theme: "Harvest Dining" when designing your Troop's gateway. Gateways must be free standing as no digging of holes is allowed. Gateways will be judged on Saturday by the staff and recognized on Sunday morning at the closing ceremony. Each unit will be responsible for their own supplies.

Camping

Camping must be confined to your Troop's campsite. We are camping on a school sports field. Please do your best to prevent divots, holes, grass damage and general garbage on the field. Please do not damage the campsite signs or wood stakes indicating your campsite in order to direct your meal judges to the right site.

Water and Grey Water

There will be water available for clean up/fire buckets/drinking/etc. at the camporee site. All units should be prepared to strain their grey water and dispose of the solids appropriately.

Fires

Fires are allowed above-ground only in a raised metal container. Be sure to have proper equipment, (rake, shovel, and water buckets) before starting a fire. All fires must be extinguished fully when no one is in camp. Bring your own wood and lighting materials. Fires must be placed on the woods side of your campsite. DO NOT CUT DOWN ANY TREES IN THE WOODS FOR ANY REASON.

Vehicles

All vehicles will be parked in the parking lot in a lined parking space. Vehicles may not park along any roads. All units should be prepared to carry their gear into their campsite as needed.

No one should be near or around the School Building. Be respectful as we are on School Property.
